

Lindfield Learning Village Stage 2

Pacific Highway works notification

August 2023

Lindfield Learning Village Stage 2 main works were finished in September 2021 and the new facilities are being enjoyed by the school.

Pacific Highway roadworks at Grosvenor Road from September 2023

As part of the project's traffic and transport strategy, we will be carrying out works to the Pacific Highway in the vicinity of Grosvenor Road to improve road access arrangements to Lindfield Learning Village. The right-hand turn bay will be increased from an approximate length of 75m to 190m, allowing a greater area for right turning cars to queue and helping avoid disrupting the flow of traffic on the Pacific Highway. This will enhance safety at the intersection without undue disruption to residents or road users.

The work is planned over the following periods:

- 12 September 2023 to 10 October 2023: Site establishment works including locating services and utilities adjustment
- 10 to 12 September 2023: Ausgrid works to move two powerpoles on the Pacific Highway away from the road to improve safety
- 10 October 2023 to 2 November 2023: Verge Works including vegetation trimming and removal
- 3 November 2023 to 18 December 2023: Road Works on the Pacific Highway

Related works by Sydney Water and Ausgrid will take place during the works listed above. We will update you prior to each stage of the works.

Key features of the works include:

- road pavement breaking and removal
- construction of new pavement
- construction of new kerbs, median and gutters
- asphaltting the new pavement
- new traffic signage
- line repainting of the new road
- the removal of the nearside lane from the northbound side of the road
- removal of bus indent lane (existing bus stop will remain in the same location).

Nightworks

In order to minimise disruption to traffic and the community, verge and road works will take place at night:

- 8:30pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday
- High noise activities such as jackhammering and concrete saw cutting will cease by midnight on all working nights.

We will not work on Friday or Saturday night, public holidays or during heavy rainfall. We apologise for the inconvenience and will apply measures to minimise the impact of noise on nearby businesses and residents.

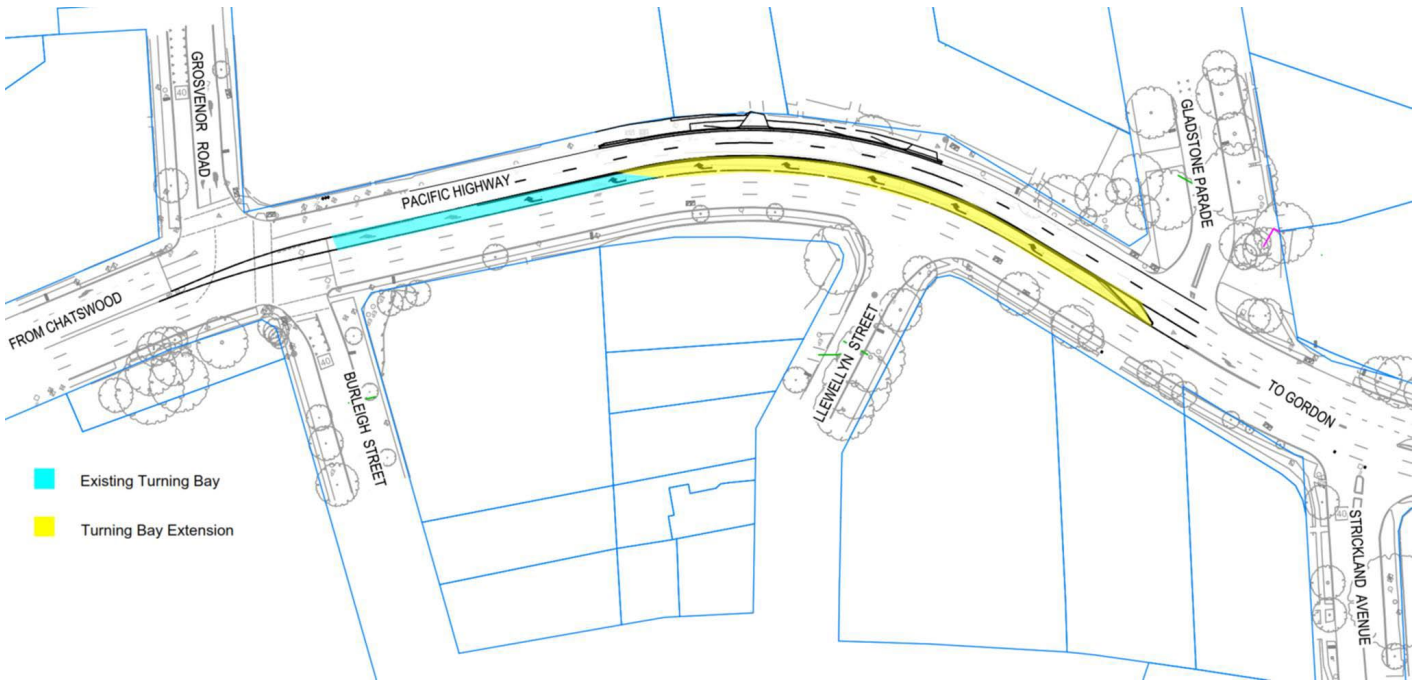

Traffic management and changes

The works will be staged to minimise impacts to the road network during construction. The staging will involve closure of one northbound lane and two southbound lanes during the night works.

Traffic controllers will be responsible for managing both pedestrian and cyclist movements around the site, particularly during works associated with removal of the existing bus indent. Clear signage will be displayed on Pacific Highway to notify pedestrians and cyclists travelling near the site of any potential changes to their route and alternative paths to be taken.
