Pacific Highway roadworks at Grosvenor Road

Lindfield Learning Village Stage 2 main works were finished in September 2021 and the new facilities are being enjoyed by the school.

As part of the project's traffic and transport strategy, we will be carrying out works to the Pacific Highway in the vicinity of Grosvenor Road to improve road access arrangements to Lindfield Learning Village.

Works Update - Driveway works at Lindfield Primary School and 234 Pacific Highway Lindfield

There are two driveways facing out onto the Pacific Highway that will be affected by works. Works will involve demolishing and removing sections of the driveway including kerb and pavement. This will require an evening closure of the driveway prior to each shift and a full closure during curing of the new pavement. We will ensure traffic controllers will be on site to safely direct pedestrians and vehicles during the works.

To reduce impacts on the school, driveway works for Lindfield Primary School are taking place during the School Holidays. Work has started on the school driveway and will continue **until Thursday 5 October 2023** and on **Sunday 8 October 2023**, **between 8.30pm to 5.30am**, weather dependent.

Driveway works are now planned at 234 Pacific Highway, Lindfield from **Monday 9 to Thursday 12 October 2023 between 8.30pm to 5.30am and will take up to four nights to complete.**

The previously notified tree removal works will be rescheduled to later date in October 2023, we will notify you when dates are confirmed.

Nightworks

In order to minimise disruption to traffic and the community, verge and road works will take place at night:

8:30pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday

High noise activities such as jackhammering and concrete saw cutting will cease by midnight on all working nights.

We will not work on Friday or Saturday night, public holidays or during heavy rainfall. We apologise for the inconvenience and will apply measures to minimise the impact of noise on nearby businesses and residents.

Traffic management and changes

The works will be staged to minimise impacts to the road network during construction. The staging will involve closure of one northbound lane and two southbound lanes during the night works.

Traffic controllers will be responsible for managing both pedestrian and cyclist movements around the site. Clear signage will be displayed on Pacific Highway to notify pedestrians and cyclists travelling near the site of any potential changes to their route and alternative paths to be taken.
