Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver Stage 2 of Lindfield Learning Village. This stage will provide additional learning spaces, specialist technical learning spaces and a senior home base focusing on specialised expertise and wellbeing support to transition students between school and their first post-school destinations.

Key features of Stage 2 include:

- refurbishment of the existing buildings
- internal fit out works, delivered in phases
- new kiss and drop and bus access
- new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and additional play space

- repurposing of the existing lecture theatres into new drama and music teaching theatres
- relocation of Aurora College (NSW Department of Education's Selective Virtual High School) to Lindfield Learning Village.

School intake area

The school intake area for Lindfield Learning Village has been determined. The process was informed by demographic advice about projected enrolments in the Lindfield area and in consultation with local primary and secondary school Principals. The intake area for Lindfield Learning Village has now been confirmed by the NSW Department of Education.

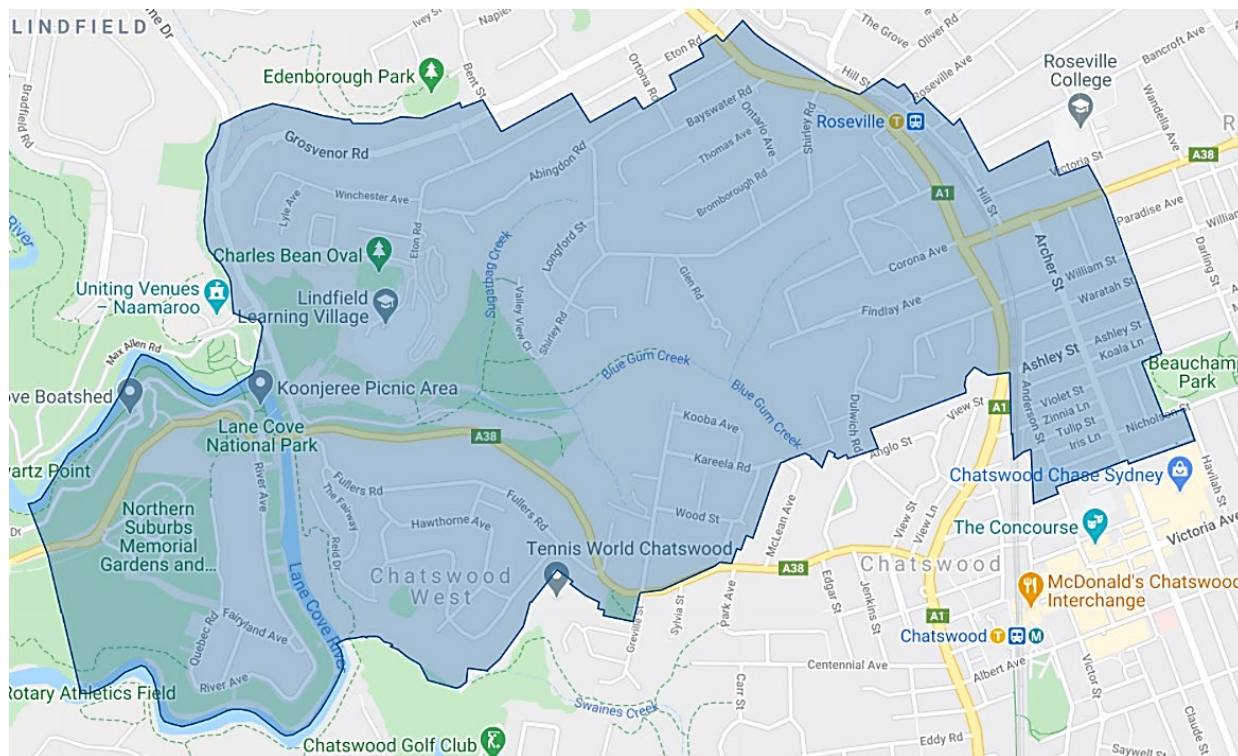

The new intake area will apply for all new enrolments from K-12 for 2022. If you live in the intake area and wish to enrol your child at Lindfield Learning Village in 2021, this will be treated as an out-of-area enrolment in line with the Department's policies. Frequently asked questions

How was the intake area for Lindfield Learning Village determined?

The process was informed by demographic advice about projected enrolments in the Lindfield area and in consultation with local primary and high school principals. The intake area for Lindfield Learning Village has now been confirmed by the NSW Department of Education.

What if I have recently moved to the future intake area and want my child to attend Lindfield Learning Village in 2021?

The standard process will apply for requests for out-of-area enrolments in accordance with the department's enrolment policy. Please contact the school if you wish to make application for an out-of-area enrolment. From 2022, students living in the area impacted by the change are able to transition if it is more convenient or preferred. However, students who are already enrolled at a different school are able to remain there to complete their education.

What if I don't live in the intake area but still want my child to attend Lindfield Learning Village in 2022?

The standard process will apply for requests for out-of-area enrolments in accordance with the department's enrolment policy. Please contact the school if you wish to make application for an out-of-area enrolment.

What if I live in the Lindfield Learning Village intake area but I want to enrol my child in our previous in-area or other school?

The standard process will apply for requests for out-of-area enrolments in accordance with the department's enrolment policy. Please contact the Principal of the school where you are seeking enrolment for further information.

What happens if I currently have a child enrolled in my previous in-area school and I want to enrol their sibling in the same school, which is now deemed out-of-area?

Families living in the area affected by the change who have a child/children already enrolled at a different school are able to stay at that school. They are also able to enrol other siblings.

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
