Community Newsletter 2 – July 2018

The Lindfield Learning Village is an exciting new K-12 school that will deliver a new model of learning while respecting the unique local character of its setting.

Work is underway on the site of the former UTS Ku-ring-gai campus to transform the unique bushland campus into a K-12 school.

Lindfield Learning Village will be delivered for day 1, term 1, 2019.

The school will be constructed in two stages in order to increase capacity as demand grows.

- » **Stage 1**, will involve the construction of learning spaces and school facilities for the first intake of up to 350 students and will be completed by the start of term 1, 2019.
- » **Stage 2**, will involve the expansion of the school facilities to provide additional capacity for term 1, 2020 and final works to provide the administration building for the school forecast to be completed by early 2021.

An 'all through learning model'

Students will benefit from the consistency of an 'all through' learning model where they are able to progress based on their level of ability rather than their age. Project-based, multidisciplinary learning will be a key feature and students will pursue an individualised learning pathway, which is responsive to their needs. A full secondary curriculum will be offered from the start of 2019 with a wide range of subject choices available.

The key elements of the education learning model being offered at Lindfield Learning Village include:

- » An "all through" school
- » Stage not age
- » Home bases
- » Project based multidisciplinary learning
- » Student directed and individualised learning
- » A flexible timetable
- » Community, university and business links.

Expressions of interest in attending the school

There has been significant interest from students and parents in the Lindfield Learning Village. To date we have received over 1,000 enrolment enquiries to attend the Lindfield Learning Village with substantial interest in all year levels.

Due to the high level of interest, the school has currently suspended enrolment enquiries while they process the enquiries they have received to date.

Construction has commenced

The construction contract for the Lindfield Learning Village was awarded to renowned local company *Taylor Construction*.

You will start to see increased activity on the site as construction work is undertaken. Works on the site over the coming months are outlined below.

Work on the site will happen from **7am – 5pm Monday to Saturday**. No work is planned for Sundays and Public Holidays.



Community consultation

Excitement about the Lindfield Learning Village continues to grow. School Infrastructure NSW has held two parent information nights and one Community Information and Feedback session between June-July 2018 with over 1,500 people coming along to find out about the Lindfield Learning Village.

Feedback to date has included:

- » Significant interest in the 'all through learning model'
- » A large number of enrolment enquiries to attend the school
- » Interest in the catchment area
- » Suggestions for increased disability access parking on the site
- » Interest in the construction schedule.

We thank everyone for their feedback to date. The project team is considering all comments received as the finer planning details for the site are progressed.
