SUBMISSION OF CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SATISFACTION OF CONDITION 42 - SSD 8114

The State Significant Development (SSD) application for the Lindfield Learning Village, (app No. 8114) received partial development consent on 24 October 2018 subject to conditions of consent including requirement for the preparation of a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) as set out in condition B42 which states:

B42. Prior to the commencement of construction, a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) must be prepared in accordance with the relevant guidelines of the NSW Heritage Council, in consultation with the Heritage Division and submitted to the satisfaction of the Planning Secretary. The CMP must be prepared by an appropriately qualified and experienced heritage consultant(s) and have appropriate skills and experience in both built form and landscape heritage with documented experience in the preparation and implementation of CMPs. The CMP must include, but not be limited to:

- (a) A summary of already documented heritage values of the site;
- (b) The development of heritage design principles for the project to retain the heritage significance of the site;
- (c) Specific mitigation measures for the site to minimise impact and to ensure the final measures selected are appropriate and the least intrusive option; and
- (d) Changes to the detailed design to mitigate heritage impacts.

The attached Conservation Management Plan has been prepared in accordance with condition B42 and satisfies this condition.

It is noted that the condition requires the CMP be prepared "in consultation with the Heritage Division." During the preparation of the CMP, Urbis Heritage made contact with the Heritage Division to facilitate consultation in accordance with the condition, however, we were advised by Katrina Stankowski (Senior Team Leader/ Regional Heritage Assessments, North Heritage Division) that they were unable to consult on the development of the CMP for the Lindfield Learning Village. This is a result of the



listing status, whereby the Lindfield Learning Village is not listed as an item under the State Heritage Register under the *Heritage Act 1977* and is only listed as a heritage item under the Ku-ring-gai Local Environmental Plan 2015, and further due to the Heritage Division having limited resources. Please refer to attached email correspondence for confirmation of the above.

The CMP has been prepared with regard to the relevant guidelines from the NSW Heritage Council and in accordance with the NSW Heritage Manual (1996), the Australia ICOMOS Burra Charter (2013) and The Conservation Plan by James Semple Kerr (2000). Thus, although consultation with the Heritage Division was not possible in the preparation of the CMP for the Lindfield Learning Village, the document has been prepared in accordance with the relevant guidelines and documentation.

We trust the attached CMP satisfies the condition B42 of the SSD application No. 8114 for the Lindfield Learning Village.

Yes, the Conservation Management Plan for the Lindfield Learning Village has been prepared as part of the SSD application. As part of the draft conditions of consent (these are yet to be formerly approved by DPE), we are required to consult with the Heritage Division. Please see draft condition below:

B42. Prior to the commencement of construction, a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) must be prepared in accordance with the relevant guidelines of the NSW Heritage Council, in consultation with the Heritage Division and submitted to the satisfaction of the Planning Secretary. The CMP must be prepared by an appropriately qualified and experienced heritage consultant(s) and have appropriate skills and experience in both built form and landscape heritage with documented experience in the preparation and implementation of CMPs. The CMP must include, but not be limited to:

- (a) A summary of already documented heritage values of the site;
- (b) The development of heritage design principles for the project to retain the heritage significance of the site;

- (c) Specific mitigation measures for the site to minimise impact and to ensure the final measures selected are appropriate and the least intrusive option; and
- (d) Changes to the detailed design to mitigate heritage impacts.

To meet this requirement, we would suggest a meeting to discuss the CMP if that is possible. I believe early on in the project Shikha was overseeing the project, but may now be overseen by Rajeev.
