## Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

The NSW Government will deliver a new co-educational high school in Liverpool by bringing together the existing Liverpool Boys and Liverpool Girls High Schools, following extensive consultation with the community.

## Project Overview

The new school will offer an expanded range of subjects for students, with purpose-built facilities to deliver access to specialised pathways into health and higher education.
