Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The new co-educational high school will offer an expanded range of subjects for students, with purpose-built facilities to deliver access to specialised pathways into health and higher education.

The new school will include:

- modern classrooms and dedicated support classrooms to cater for up to 2,000 students
- a multipurpose hall, new library and canteen
- sports courts and sports field
- landscaping, yarning circle and covered walkways
- staff car park and staff and student bike parking
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

Progress summary

Exhibition of the planning application, known as a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) is now closed. REF submissions are being reviewed and considered as part of the REF process. We expect to receive planning determination later this year.

We are pleased to announce that the contract for the main works construction has been awarded to Hansen Yuncken Pty Ltd. We will work with them to progress the timeline for construction and detailed design of the new school.

- The REF determination, with any modifications, will be published on the <u>NSW Planning Portal</u> for <u>Division 5.1 (Part 5) Activities</u>, and we will advise the community when this occurs.
- Progressing with the detailed design and timeline for the permanent co-educational high school.
- Beginning the installation of the temporary Liverpool Boys High School and associated works.

Co-education opportunities from 2027

Year 7 students will learn in co-educational settings from 2027 ahead of the new school opening in 2028. Students in other grades will also have access to some co-educational learning opportunities between the existing Liverpool Boys and Liverpool Girls High Schools in 2027.
