Upgrading Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools

The NSW Government is planning an upgrade to Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools, which will provide additional permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to support the growing population in Western Sydney.

What have we done so far?

The project is currently in the master planning phase; since the announcement of the project in the 2018/19 NSW Budget, we have been working on the following:

- Further analysing demographic trends and the school community needs.
- Conducting site investigations to assess the condition of existing buildings, site surroundings and onsite risks.
- We have appointed a design team to work in consultation with the PCG. Design work so far includes multiple master plan options and discussion of the advantages and disadvantages of each.
- Transport analysis, contamination assessment and project staging as part of this project.

What's next?

The preferred design will be included in the final business case, which will be complete by early 2023. We will submit the final business case to NSW Treasury for approval in mid-2023 and lodge the planning application in late 2023.
