

Mainsbridge School (relocation)

Works notification

February 2020

Mainsbridge School for Specific Purposes (SSP) is being relocated to part of the existing Warwick Farm Public School site.

An amount of asbestos containing material (bonded asbestos) has been identified during site remediation works at Warwick Farm Public School on the construction site.

Bonded asbestos means it is attached to other material, such as cement or vinyl floor tiles and cannot be crumbled by light pressure. The affected areas have been covered and contained.

Hours of work

The material will be removed, weather permitting, by a licensed asbestos removal contractor between 8:00am - 1:00pm on the following dates: Saturday 29 February 2020, Saturday 7 March 2020, Saturday 14 March 2020 and Saturday 21 March 2020.

Safety measures in place

Safety measures have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community. The area has been secured and appropriate control and monitoring measures are installed.

Works will be conducted in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW requirements. Testing will be completed after each stage of works, to ensure the site is safe for students, staff and the community. A clearance certificate must be issued by a consultant hygienist after each weekend of work, in order for students and staff to return to school, and work on the upgrade to continue.

The health, safety and well-being of the school community and local residents is our highest priority. Please be assured that these works will not pose a risk to the community.
