#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

### **Project overview**

Mainsbridge School has been relocated next to the existing Warwick Farm Public School.

The new learning environment caters for a range of disabilities. Some key features of the new building include:

- flexible learning zones
- immersive sensory room
- hydrotherapy pool
- living skills learning areas
- accessible entry and pathways.

#### Final works nearing completion

The final works at Mainsbridge School are nearly finished. The work on the sports field, a bike track and soft fall and play equipment area are now completed. These areas are now open and in use by students across Mainsbridge and Warwick Farm Public School.

Due to the ongoing wet weather conditions, some minor works are still remaining. This work includes the removal of the contractors site shed and site fencing, and resurfacing of these grounds. These works are expected to be completed in the next few weeks, depending on weather conditions.
