

Mainsbridge school relocation

Works notification

March 2021

A project is underway to relocate the Mainsbridge School for Specific Purposes (SSP) to part of the existing Warwick Farm Public School site.

New parking restrictions and traffic rules to be introduced on Williamson Crescent

New school day parking and traffic measures will be introduced on Williamson Crescent to help keep children safe, manage traffic flow and minimise congestion surrounding the new Mainsbridge School for Specific Purposes.

The School Zone speed limit rules are already in place and the new parking conditions start from 19 April. These are outlined below:

New Traffic Condition	Rule	Days of parking and traffic management
No Stopping Zone between 8:00am – 9:30am and 2:00pm – 4:00pm	You must not stop your vehicle at any point on the road or kerb unless there is a medical or other emergency.	All School Days (Monday – Friday)
No Parking Zone between 8:00am – 9:30am and 2:00pm – 4:00pm	You must not stop for more than two minutes. You must remain in or within three metres of the vehicle. Mobility Parking Permit holders are allowed to park for up to five minutes	All School Days (Monday – Friday)
40km School Zone speed limit from 8:00am – 9:30am and 2:30pm – 4:00pm	Motorists must drive no faster than 40 km/h through the School Zone.	All School Days (Monday – Friday)

A map showing the location of the parking and traffic conditions is provided overleaf.
