Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Upcoming improvements

Work is underway to improve the operations and amenities at Maitland Grossmann High School. This work is being undertaken while we explore options for the school facilities into the future. The improvements that have now commenced will include:



painting the hall, Block D and Block C



installing covered walkways

installing a shade structure



a new demountable VET hospitality kitchen



improving the appearance of Block E

Painting

The exteriors of the hall, Block D (school entry) and Block C will be repainted. The painting team began work on Friday 20 June 2025. The team will also be painting the interior administration area in Block D. The internal painting will be scheduled over the school holidays to reduce impact on school operations.

Covered walkways

To improve access around the school, covered walkways will be installed to service the demountable buildings located near the library and the sports field. We will provide an update when this installation is scheduled.

Shade structure

We are working with the school leadership on the most suitable location to construct a shade structure to increase access to shaded areas for students. Further updates will be provided prior to the shade structure being installed.

New demountable VET hospitality kitchen

While options for the future are being considered, we have made the decision to pause the VET hospitality kitchen conversion for Block D. This is to ensure that we invest in the best long-term solution for the school. In the interim a demountable VET hospitality kitchen will be installed at the school in the October 2025 school holidays.

Students currently completing a VET hospitality course will still be able to meet their course requirements using the kitchen located in the school hall until the new demountable kitchen is installed.

Improving the appearance of Block E

We are exploring options to improve the appearance of current access restrictions around Block E, including how we can incorporate design into the temporary fencing structures securing the building to improve the appearance for staff and students. We will share updates with the school community as these plans develop.

Health and safety

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority. The independent hygienist is continuing to monitor Maitland Grossmann High School and the clearance certificate issued to use all buildings on site except for Block E, remains in place.

Next steps

We are working through the options for the future of the school facilities and expect to have an update in Term 4, 2025. Thank you for your patience while we work though the best options for the Maitland Grossmann High School community. We look forward to sharing more information with you.
