School holiday works notification | June 2023

School Infrastructure NSW regularly inspects and maintains school infrastructure as part of a comprehensive and ongoing program to keep school assets in optimal condition and ensure the safety and wellbeing of our school community across more than 2,200 NSW schools.

The school holidays are the ideal time for some maintenance projects as it means work can take place without disrupting learning.

Planned maintenance over the holidays may involve working with hazardous materials such as asbestos or lead containing material. This is to notify you of this work.

Project overview

We are upgrading Manly Village Public School to meet the needs of the local community. The project includes relocating and upgrading administration facilities, and a new multi-purpose learning space. It will also include a new out of school hours care (OOSHC) facilities in the school hall.

We have consulted with the school to finalise the detailed design for the project. To prepare for the start of construction, site establishment activities are now underway, including the installation of site safety fencing and gates.

Planned maintenance over the winter school holidays

As part of the upgrade, we will be removing 2 trees, located towards the north east corner of the school, in the school car park. This will be done over the holiday period to ensure minimal disruption to staff and students.

Work to remove the trees will take place during the July school holidays, from the end of school on Friday 30 June to Monday 17 July 2023.

Development Application (DA) approved for tree removal

A Development Application (DA) has been approved by Northern Beaches Council, to remove two *Casuarina cunninghamiana* trees, which will allow works to begin. The trees are approximately 16m in height and are located towards the north east corner of the site, in the school car park. They will be removed during/outside school hours, to limit noise and disruption impacts on students and staff. The trees will be replaced by planting two trees towards the south east side of the site, within an existing outdoor play area to the west of Building E.
