

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Marie Bashir Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Marie Bashir Public School. This will provide:

- the refurbishment of 18 classrooms
- two additional lifts
- the refurbishment of existing Block A disabled toilets.

Progress summary

The refurbishment of the 18 classrooms is nearing completion.

Summer school holiday works

Construction work will continue including the lifts in building D to be installed over the school holidays.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7am to 5pm and Saturdays, 8am to 1pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Frequently asked questions

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year period?

Schiavello will be working over the Christmas and New Year period. However, no construction will occur on Sundays or public holidays.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Measures are in place to minimise noise and dust impacts including:

- Selecting and using machinery to limit noise and vibration
- Using a site layout that avoids truck reversing, idling and requires fewer vehicle movements
- Complying with best practice environmental standards to reduce dust
- Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic controllers will be used on site to assist with traffic movement where necessary. Vehicles entering, exiting and driving around the site will give way to pedestrians at all times.
