Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The upgrade of Matthew Pearce Public School has provided additional fit-for-purpose classrooms and new facilities to meet anticipated enrolment growth in Northwest Sydney. The project delivered 3 new buildings with new flexible modern classrooms, a new hall with out of school hours (OOSH) care facilities, new student amenities and facilities for specialist support classes which have replaced demountable buildings. A new sports field and running track will also be built as part of the upgrade.

Progress summary

We are currently refurbishing 3 classrooms into learning support classrooms. In late 2025, we will share an update with the community about when these facilities will be available for the community. The construction of the sports field and running track is the final stage of the upgrade at Matthew Pearce Public School. Planning approval will be sought though a Review of Environmental Factors before the construction of the sports field starts. We anticipate this work to start in late 2025 and be ready for students to use in early 2026.

We expect to release the tender for the sports field upgrade in mid Term 3. After the Review of Environmental Factors is approved and the contract is awarded, we can start work on the sports field and running track.
