Schools at the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct | **Public Domain Improvement Works**

Dear neighbour,

As per our notification 28 June 2021, we are delivering a package of public domain improvement works that will assist teachers, students and visitors to access the new school buildings, as well as improve the amenity in the local area.

As part of the public domain improvement works the project team are required to undertake some additional asphalt works in the following locations:

- Bowden Street in between Squire Street and Thorn Street.
- Squires Street at the intersection of Bowden Street

The works will be undertaken in stages, pending weather:

- 1. Bowden Street from the 20 June 2022 25 June 2022, from 7am 6pm
- 2. Squires Street from 27 June 2022 1 July from 7am 6pm

The work includes non-destructive excavation, new asphalt to the various road areas, line marking, make good works and minor landscaping. There may be short periods of truck and heavy machinery for delivery during this period.

Work hours

Work will take place between 7:00am and 6:00pm from Monday to Friday and between 8:00am and 1:00pm on Saturdays, weather permitting. Overnight there will be traffic control to assist with restricting access over the new asphalt in order to not damage the works. Traffic controllers will direct vehicles and pedestrians for the duration of the works. Additional lighting may be required to support overnight traffic control although noisy works will not be carried out beyond 6:00pm. Further to this, no work will be carried out on Sundays or public holidays

Traffic and access changes

There will be changes to pedestrian and vehicle access on Bowden Street and Squire Street, and surrounding streets during this work as follows:

- Traffic controllers will be onsite to safely direct pedestrians and vehicles around sites
- Temporary impacts to parking in the direct vicinity of the works, including limited parking on Bowden Street, Macpherson Street and Squire Street adjacent to the works.

This work is required to help ensure the safe movement of pedestrians and traffic on Bowden Street, Squire Street and Macpherson Street. This work has been completed in line with the design developed in consultation with and endorsed by City of Ryde Council and Transport NSW (TfNSW).
