



Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct

Project update | September 2023

Project overview

Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School relocated to their new home at the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct in early 2022. Side by side, the schools have formed a connected education community, supporting students within the one precinct throughout their school years and beyond. The new school facilities cater for 1,000 primary school students, 1,500 secondary school students and a further 120 Intensive English Centre students.

Progress update

We are delivering a package of Public Domain Improvement works that will assist students, school staff and visitors to access the new school buildings safely, as well as improve the amenity in the local area. The safety of students, school staff and the local community is the highest priority.

Most of the Public Domain Improvement works were finished before both schools opened in their new location, including the Mellor Street and See Street pedestrian crossing works that are now finished.

Next steps – new Hermitage Road footpath

Work on the new footpath on the western side of Hermitage Road has started. Recently finished works include the relocation and upgrade of street lighting and power poles, removal of the old power poles, relocation of Telstra and NBN services and installation of a new Jemena gas main.

Upcoming works over the coming months will include:

- installing water barriers and new trenching for diversion of a Sydney Water watermain
- relocating Optus and Telstra ground assets
- installing temporary access stairs leading to the Sydney Water property
- preparation for construction of the new footpath.

Standard working hours will be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.



Traffic, parking and access changes

As previously advised, there will be changes to pedestrian and vehicle movements along Hermitage Road from Victoria Road to Rhodes Street. These will include:

- Traffic control to ensure the safe movement of pedestrians and traffic.
- Temporary changes to traffic movements or parking, which are clearly signposted and monitored by traffic controllers.

We anticipate these works will be finished in early 2024. Ongoing notifications will be issued to provide regular updates on the progress of these works.
