Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Progress summary - Hermitage Road footpath

Public domain improvement works on the new Hermitage Road footpath are nearing completion. The new footpath will aid students, school staff and visitors to access the new school buildings safely as well as improve amenities in the local area.

During Terms 3 and 4, works to relocate pipes and cables were completed including works undertaken in partnership with Sydney Water and Telstra. Vegetation removal, rock excavation, works to install a retaining wall and the removal of kerbs have also been completed.

Next steps

- Construction of new kerb and gutter along Hermitage Road.
- Landscaping works next to the new footpath.
- Completion and opening of the new Hermitage Road footpath.

Summer holiday works

Over the school summer holidays, you may notice work at the precinct continuing on public domain infrastructure.

Standard working hours will be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturday in accordance with approved planning conditions. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.

As part of the continuous development in the precinct, upcoming construction work may cause changes to traffic and parking conditions once these works are underway. Measures will be put in place to ensure the safety of students and community members. Traffic controllers will be monitoring the works and advising traffic movement accordingly.
