Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct Project update | February 2024

Project Overview

Welcome to Term 1 2024!

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School relocated to their new home at the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct in early 2022. Side by side, the schools have formed a connected education community, supporting students within the one precinct throughout their school years and beyond. The new school facilities cater for 1,000 primary school students, 1,500 secondary school students and a further 120 Intensive English Centre students.

Progress update

During 2024 we will continue to deliver a package of public domain improvement works that will assist students, school staff and visitors to access the new school buildings safely as well as improve the amenity in the local area. The safety of students, school staff and the local community are the highest priority.

Most of the public domain improvement works were finished before both schools opened in their new location. The remaining works centre on a new footpath on Hermitage Road.

New Hermitage Road footpath

As part of the public domain works in the local area, work is continuing to construct the footpath along the western side of Hermitage Road between the Sydney Water entrance and Rhodes Street. These works are ongoing, with key milestones recently completed including starting the Sydney Water pipe diversion works and the connection of the existing Rhodes Street footpath to the Sydney Trains driveway.

Upcoming works will include:

continuation of trenching for new Sydney Water watermain diversions

- new cabling for the relocation of Telstra in ground assets
- construction of footings for the new footpath.


Standard working hours will be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays in accordance with approved planning conditions. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised. We anticipate these works will be finished by the end of 2024. Ongoing notifications will be issued to provide regular updates and advise on the progress of these works.

Traffic, parking and access changes

As previously advised, there will be changes to pedestrian and vehicle movements along Hermitage Road from Victoria Road to Rhodes Street. These changes include:

- traffic control where required to ensure the safe movement of pedestrians and traffic
- temporary changes to traffic movements or parking which are clearly signposted and monitored by traffic controllers
- impacts to parking and traffic movement in the direct vicinity of the works.
