



# Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct

Project update | May 2024

## Project Overview

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School relocated to their new home at the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct in early 2022. Side by side, the schools have formed a connected education community, supporting students within the one precinct throughout their school years and beyond. The new school facilities cater for 1,000 primary school students, 1,500 secondary school students and a further 120 Intensive English Centre students.

## Progress update

Public domain improvement works will continue throughout Term 2, 2024. These works will assist students, school staff and visitors to access the new school buildings safely as well as improve the amenity in the local area. The safety of students, school staff and the local community are our highest priority.

Most of the public domain improvement works were finished before both schools opened in their new location. The construction of a new footpath on Hermitage Road is the final element of the public domain improvement works to be completed.

## New Hermitage Road footpath

A key milestone was recently achieved on the Hermitage Road footpath works, with a critical shutdown period to carry out underground works successfully completed. Work is continuing to construct the footpath along the western side of Hermitage Road between the Sydney Water entrance and Rhodes Street.

It is anticipated that the construction of the Hermitage Road footpath will be completed by the end of 2024. The original schedule has been re-adjusted to account for unexpected underground finds, approval from other agencies and weather delays on key shutdown dates.



## Next steps

Upcoming works will include:

- final Sydney Water connection and shutdown to complete the new Sydney Water water main diversions
- final stage of Telstra works
- excavation and construction of footings for the new footpath.


Standard working hours will be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays in accordance with the approved planning conditions. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised. Ongoing notifications will be issued to provide regular updates and advise on the progress of these works.

## Traffic, parking and access changes

As previously advised, there will be changes to pedestrian and vehicle movements along Hermitage Road from Victoria Road to Rhodes Street. These changes include:

- traffic control where required to ensure the safe movement of pedestrians and traffic
- temporary changes to traffic movements or parking which are clearly signposted and monitored by traffic controllers
- restrictions to parking and traffic movement in the direct vicinity of the works.
