Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct

Summer Works Notification | December 2021

Project overview

A project is underway to relocate Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School to the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct, following the construction of new facilities. The new schools will be open from Term 2, 2022.

A new Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub, along with a multi-storey car park is also being built at TAFE NSW Meadowbank campus. Construction is scheduled for completion in late 2022. The technology-focused campus will sit alongside the new primary school and high school facilities to form the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct.

Progress summary

The complete structure of the new school facilities is now in place and fit out of all rooms and areas of the buildings are continuing as the school prepares to welcome students and teachers in Term 2, 2022. Work is now underway on the multi-use sports courts, high school running track and the high school gymnasium.

There has also been significant progress on construction of the TAFE NSW Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub and the multi-storey carpark. Roof sheeting has been completed on the south wing of the Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub and is now progressing on the northern wing. Work on the façades is underway, and the internal fit out has also started, with the Hub now taking shape.

Summer Work

Works on the Meadowbank Schools over the summer holidays will include:

- public domain improvement works, including line marking, lighting and landscaping
- internal fit out of the school facilities and landscaping of external areas
- installation of recreational courts and covered outdoor learning areas.

Works on the Meadowbank TAFE site over the summer holidays include:

- demolition of buildings C, D and E, as well as associated structures including sheds, footpaths and driveways
- internal fit out of the Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub.

No construction work will take place on either site during the Christmas and New Year period as outlined below.

- Meadowbank Schools: The construction site will be closed from 7 pm on Thursday 23 December 2021, with work resuming from 7 am on Wednesday 5 January 2022.
- Meadowbank TAFE: The construction site will be closed from 7 pm on Tuesday 21 December 2021, with work resuming from 7 am on Tuesday 4 January 2022.

TAFE NSW Multi-storey car park - Proposed modification

On 25 August 2020, consent was granted for State Significant Development application (SSD 10349) for the project, which included construction of a two-storey car park with three levels of parking.

TAFE NSW has submitted a proposed modification to SSD 10349 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) to build an additional two levels to the car park, which would result in an increase to a four-storey car park, with five levels of parking.

The proposed modification would be additional and dedicated car parking spaces for TAFE students, teachers and visitors to relieve parking demand on local streets in the area.

It is expected that the proposed modification will be placed on public exhibition in January 2022.
