## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

## Project overview

A project is underway to relocate Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School to the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct, following the construction of new facilities.

The Meadowbank Education Precinct will cater for 1,000 primary school students, 1,500 secondary school students and a further 120 Intensive English Centre students.

The new school facilities will house the separate primary school and high school in multilevel, multipurpose buildings with play spaces and landscaped areas.

## Progress summary

Work is progressing well with remediation work within the site complete.

Early construction works including earthworks, piling and the installation of in-ground services have also been completed.

Major construction activities have also commenced with three tower cranes now in place to move materials onto and around the site. Scaffolding for the main builds is also being put up on site and work on the structure has commenced and is progressing well.

We are committed to working together with our school communities and other stakeholders to deliver the best possible learning facilities for students. We will keep the local school community and residents informed as the project progresses

## Detailed design

We have been working with both the primary and high school communities to finalise the detailed design of the school buildings. This includes design features that meet each school's specific operational needs for classrooms and facilities.

For Marsden High School, the science labs and design and technology rooms, as well as the school library, administration office and school hall have been additional areas of focus.
