Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to relocate Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School to the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct, following the construction of new facilities. The Meadowbank Education Precinct will cater for 1000 primary school students, 1500 secondary school students and a further 120 Intensive English Centre students. The new school facilities will house the separate primary school and high school in multilevel, multipurpose buildings with play spaces and landscaped areas.

Relocation to the new school facilities

Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School will move to the new school facilities at Rhodes street from Term 2, 2022. The challenging circumstances throughout the evolving Covid-19 restrictions have had impacts across the construction industry and the delivery of our projects. The relocation was originally planned for the start of 2022. While this delay is unavoidable, the teams are working hard to deliver the new facilities.
