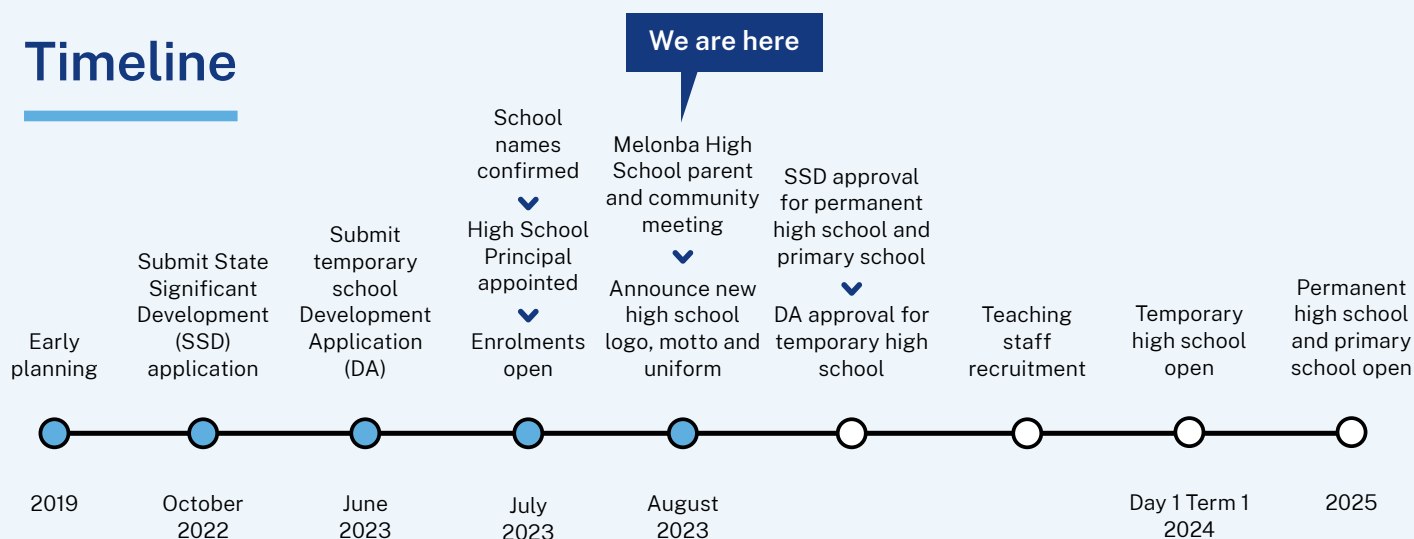
Online enrolment is now open

Melonba High School and Public School project update

Site establishment to prepare the site for construction has begun for Melonba Public School, Melonba High School and the temporary high school. This includes setting up site fencing, site offices and sheds and construction of a contractor car park within both sites.

We are awaiting Development Application (DA) consent for the temporary school and State Significant Development Application (SSD) consent for the permanent high school and primary school. Once the DA and SSD are approved, installation of the temporary school facilities and main works construction at the permanent school site will begin.

Richard Crookes Construction (RCC) has been awarded the design and construct main works contract to build the permanent high school and primary school. RCC will progress with the detailed design of the school and start main works construction once planning approval has been received.

Melonba Public School

In order to maximise play space, the primary school will be 3 storeys, with learning spaces grouped in zones that may focus on the curriculum or school stage. The new primary school will deliver:

- technology rich classrooms to accommodate up to 1000 students
- specialist support classrooms
- multi-purpose hall for sports and performance,
- library, canteen and administration facilities
- out of school hours care
- covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- sports courts and outdoor play areas.

Melonba High School

The new high school is designed to be 3 storeys to maximise outdoor space, with learning spaces grouped in zones that may focus on the curriculum or school stage. The new high school will deliver:

- technology rich classrooms to accommodate up to 2000 students
- library with senior study spaces and meeting areas
- specialist support classrooms
- multi-purpose hall for sports and performance
- hospitality and kitchen spaces
- multi-media and visual arts classrooms
- indoor/outdoor learning areas
- sports courts and oval
- sports courts and outdoor play.

Temporary Melonba High School

The temporary high school is being planned to start operating from Day 1 Term 1 2024 in purpose-built temporary facilities located at the corner of Galah Street and Rakali Parade.

The temporary high school will deliver:

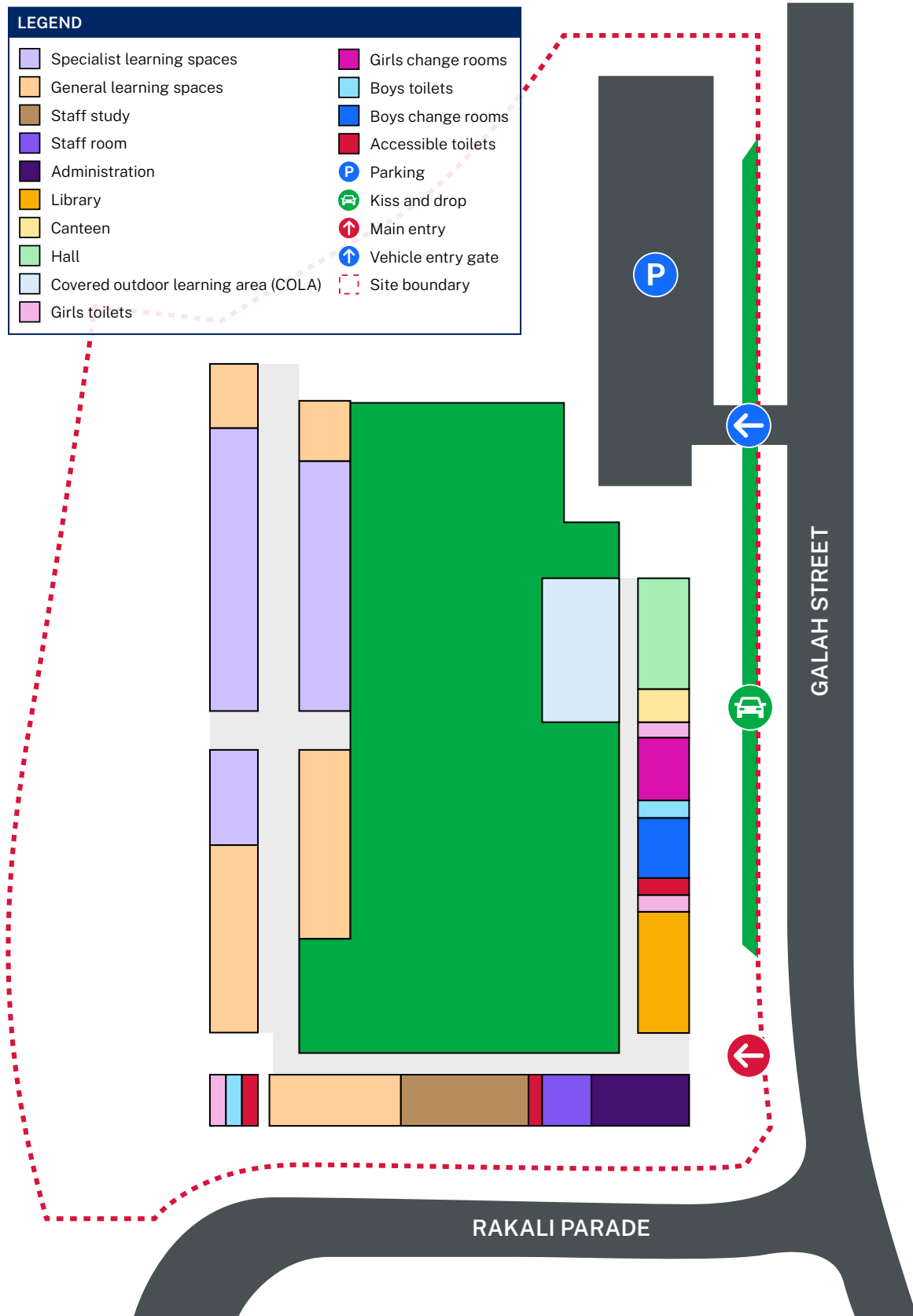
- classrooms to accommodate up to 400 Years 7 and 8 students
- specialist classrooms
- hall, library, canteen and administration facilities
- dedicated toilets and change rooms
- on-site staff parking
- dedicated pick up and drop off bay.

Frequently asked questions

Who can enrol in the temporary Melonba High School for 2024?

The temporary high school will accept enrolments for Years 7 and 8 students within the intake area. Visit schoolfinder.education.nsw.gov.au to access the primary school's intake area.

Children enrolled within the intake area will be prioritised over enrolments outside the intake area.

If you're unable to complete the online enrolment or plan to move within the intake area in 2024, please email melonba-h.school@det.nsw.edu.au or contact 02 9830 2000 detailing your circumstances.

What if my child/children are enrolled at another high school?

Your child/children can remain in their current school or enrol at Melonba High School if you live within the intake area.

The Department encourages all students to attend the school they are zoned for and will have policies to ensure a smooth transition to the new school, including collaboration between staff from both schools to understand each student's specific learning needs.

How do I apply for a teaching position at the new high school?

How do I apply for an administrative position at the new high school?

Will the temporary facilities be of good quality?

Temporary schools are flexible, modular spaces that help schools to operate while the planning and construction of permanent facilities are underway. Elements such as accessibility, student wellbeing, comfort and technology are at the core of how the temporary facilities are designed and delivered.
