Supporting high quality education

The NSW Government is committed to providing infrastructure that supports high quality education for all students in NSW, investing in new and upgraded facilities as well as the ongoing maintenance of schools.

Project overview

The redevelopment of Melrose Park Public School will provide new classrooms and core facilities to meet anticipated enrolment growth in the area. The project is currently in the planning phase and will potentially include:

- new classrooms and support learning classrooms
- new staff administration facilities
- a new library
- a new hall and covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

The final scope of the upgrade will be subject to business case and statutory planning approvals.

What have we done so far?

During the early planning phase we have:

- further analysed demographic trends and the school community needs through a School Climate Survey
- conducted site investigations
- worked with internal architects to develop masterplan options.

What's next?

- Finalising the business case, which will be subject to government approval.
- Ongoing development of the design in consultation with representatives from the Department of Education and Melrose Park Public School.




- the design and spatial arrangements of indoor learning spaces
