Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new school hall at Milperra Public School. The new school hall will include a stage and storage facilities while the existing hall will be repurposed as part of a separate project.

Progress summary

- Intrec Management Pty Ltd has been awarded the construction contract for the project.
- Intrec will start detailed design and prepare documentation for the Complying Development Certificate planning approval.
- Site establishment is scheduled to start Monday 18 October. This involves the installation of temporary fencing; sediment and erosion control; and site offices and amenities.
- Main works, which starts with site remediation, is scheduled to commence on Monday 1 November.

Site remediation

During a recent investigation of below-ground material, suspected asbestos containing material (ACM) was found in the location of the new school hall. The material has been confirmed as containing friable asbestos, which requires remediation prior to construction works proceeding.

From Monday 1 November, site remediation activities will take place. Safety measures and monitoring will be put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community. Once remediation activities commence the area will be cordoned off and remain out of bounds to students and staff until remediation is completed and clearance certificates have been issued.

This work will be completed as a necessary improvement to the school.

Working hours

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 5 pm and Saturday, 8am to 3pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.
