

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

An exciting project is underway to deliver a new hall at Milperra Public School. The new school hall will include a stage and storage facilities, while the existing hall will be repurposed as part of a separate project.

Progress summary

- The Complying Development Certificate (CDC) has been issued under the State Environment Planning Policy (Educational Establishments and Child Care Facilities) 2017, which provides the planning approval for this project
- The contractor has established the site, installing fencing, site offices, and amenities.
- Main works, including site remediation, began on 13 November.



Summer holidays

During the summer holiday period (Monday 20 December 2021 to Thursday 27 January 2022) our contractors will complete the following works:

- Upgrades to pedestrian pathways to improve accessibility
- Trenching and installation of conduits for service connections
- Installation of screw piles and footings
- Installation of formwork and reinforcement and pouring of concrete slab.

Noise will be kept to a minimum as best as possible during the construction period. We will provide advance notice of work to the local community, particularly when we anticipate high noise generating works.

Working hours

Working hours are Monday to Saturday, 7 am to 5 pm. Remediation works will occur on Saturdays only to minimise any risk to the school community and the general public due to the development. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.
