In March, the Contractor will start excavation for the onsite detention tank (OSD). This will involve removing a small amount of asbestos-containing material.

Testing conducted by an independent hygienist has confirmed that the material is bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

As a precaution, the area has been cordoned off and will remain out of bounds to students and staff until remediation is completed.

The area will be remediated in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Working hours

Working hours are Monday to Saturday, 7 am to 5 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. Please note that works on the service conduit and pathway upgrades will happen outside of school hours.

All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.
