Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Millthorpe Public School to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the local community. Subject to planning approval, the upgrade will deliver a new two-storey learning hub including 10 new flexible learning spaces (classrooms), a new library and maker spaces. Existing buildings will also be renovated to provide an upgraded administration area and new staff room. Heritage Block B will be internally renovated and new covered outdoor areas and walkways installed.

Community information session

You are invited to attend a community information session to find out more about the project. The session will outline what you can expect during early site establishment works and explain how we will work with the school to minimise disruption to students and the wider community. It will also be an opportunity to meet members of the project team.
