Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Millthorpe Public School to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the local community.

The upgrade will deliver:

- a new two-storey learning hub including:
 - o 10 new flexible learning spaces (classrooms)
 - o a new library
 - o maker spaces
- an upgrade of existing buildings to provide an improved administration area and new staff rooms
- an internal renovation of Heritage Block B
- new covered outdoor areas and walkways
- an upgrade to the existing COLA (including painting, new lighting and resurfacing of the court)
- additional roof cover outside the hall and canteen building.

Progress summary

Work is continuing on the learning hub, with electrical, solar power, lift installation and roofing works now complete. External works including cladding and brickwork are underway and internal fit outs consisting of flooring, joinery and installation of services have begun. The learning hub is expected to be completed and ready for use mid Term 1 2023.

Summer holiday works

The following work activities will take place during the summer school holidays:

- removal of scaffolding from learning hub structure
- completion of sunshade and external brickwork
- external painting
- external plant room concrete pour.

There will be increased truck movement around the Redmond Oval carpark during this time but minimal impacts to the community are expected as a result of the holiday works.

Next steps

Students and staff will return from their summer holidays to the currently used buildings for Day 1 Term 1 2023, with the transition to the new learning hub taking place mid Term 1 2023.

When work on the learning hub is complete, refurbishment work will begin on buildings B, D and G. These works are primarily for the staff administration areas and include the installation of a new front entrance counter and upgrades to the office area and finishes.

Frequently asked questions

What time of the day is construction work taking place?

Construction working hours at Millthorpe Public School will be 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday and 7 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

How are the community being kept safe during construction?

The safety of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Throughout the entire construction period rigorous safety and security measures will be put in place. There will be regular consultation with the school to discuss construction progress.


