Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The Development Application (DA) for the upgrade to Millthorpe Public School was approved by Blayney Shire Council in December 2021.

The upgrade will deliver a new two-storey learning hub including 10 new flexible learning spaces (classrooms), a new library and additional practical activity areas. Existing buildings will be renovated to provide an improved administration area and new staff room. The existing Heritage Block B will be internally renovated while new covered outdoor areas and walkways will be installed to complete this exciting upgrade.

Progress summary

Early site establishment activities started at Millthorpe Public School during the school summer holidays. Fences have been installed to establish a site boundary and site sheds will soon arrive on site to provide a site office and amenities for construction personnel. The existing computer lab will be demolished during Term 1 2022 in preparation for main construction works.

The project team is now finalising the construction contract and we expect to appoint a builder shortly.




