## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

## **Project overview**

A project is underway to upgrade Millthorpe Public School to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the local community. Subject to planning approval, the upgrade proposes to deliver a new two-storey learning hub including 10 new flexible learning spaces (classrooms), a new library and maker spaces. Existing buildings will also be upgraded to provide improved administration area and new staff rooms. The heritage Block B will be internally renovated and new covered outdoor areas and walkways installed.

## **Progress summary**

A Development Application (DA) was lodged with Blayney Shire Council in April 2021. The project team is addressing feedback received during the public exhibition period.

An Early Contractor Involvement (ECI) contract has been awarded to Lipman PTY Ltd. Lipman are finalising the detailed design in consultation with the school including selection of furniture, fixtures and equipment (FFE). Lipman are also preparing a construction methodology which will minimise impacts to the school and the local community wherever feasible.


## **Next steps**
