
Milton Public School upgrade

As part of this investment Milton Public School will receive an upgrade that will include:




14 new standard classrooms

Upgrading Milton Public School

The upgrade at Milton Public School will replace 11 temporary teaching spaces with state of the art permanent classrooms.

The new two-storey building will include:

- 14 general learning classrooms
- 3 support learning classrooms
- New student amenities.

Progress Summary


The master plan and concept design have now been completed by the design team following consultation with the Project Reference Group (PRG). The PRG involves key stakeholders including local educational experts, architects, planners and design professionals in order to ensure designs are fit for purpose.

Next Steps

The design team has almost completed the next stage of the design. This stage includes defining building materials, room details, and the furniture, fixtures and equipment (FF&E) to be used. The project team is consulting with the school leadership to ensure that the classroom designs and layouts support teaching and learning needs.

Additionally, we are finalising the necessary documentation to seek planning approval and start the tender process for appointing a builder.

The timeline for construction will be finalised when the builder has been appointed, and the project has planning approval.



How standardised learning hub layouts work in practice


Step 1

Standardised design for a school learning hub, featuring 4 classrooms and a learning commons.



Step 2

The design is modified to suit the school context outlined in the education rationale. Schools can include practical activity areas (PAAs), STEM spaces or other multi-purpose spaces (MPSs) that support collaboration, preparation or sensory needs.




Step 3

Furniture settings are selected to align to local teaching and learning requirements. Furniture selection is supported by professional learning and other resources.


