

Mona Vale Public School Upgrade

Project update | December 2022

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Mona Vale Public School. The project will deliver a new building (Block R), a new performance space (Block S), upgrades and refurbishment of Blocks A, B, D, E, H and N, and new staff and administration spaces.

Progress summary

Refurbishment of Blocks A, B ad H have continued throughout Term 4 and are expected to be finished in time for Day 1 Term 1 2023.

Landscaping of the access pathway from the front entrance to the school's new centre has progressed with the pouring of the concrete pathway, putting in the sandstone curved seating nooks, and planting. We expect to finish this landscaping by the end of this year.

External work in the new centre of the school has progressed with the sunshade steel framing completed, ready for the shade cover to be put in over the upcoming summer holidays.

Work on the new performance space (Block S) has continued with the structural steel wall and roof frame put in. Installation of the external wall cladding is currently in progress.

Next steps

- Work will continue throughout the upcoming summer holidays while the school is on their Christmas break.
- Refurbishment works on Blocks A, B and H are expected to be finished, ready for staff and students to use by Day 1
 Term 1 2023.
- Work on the lift to Block E and the amenities in Block N will continue and are also on track to be finished by the start of 2023.
- We will remove 6 of the 12 demountable classrooms by the end of the year.
- Construction of the new performance space will continue with wall cladding, external landscaping and working on the school's interior will start soon.
- The school's heritage bell and pavers will be reinstated as part of the landscaping works adjacent to Block B.
