



Project update | September 2022

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Mona Vale Public School. The project will deliver:

- a new building (Block R) containing 6 learning spaces and 3 support classes
- upgrades and refurbishments to Blocks A, B, D, E, H and N which contain a new library, learning spaces, support units, reading rooms, hall, canteen, staff facilities and amenities
- a new performance space
- a new staff and administration space.

Progress summary

• Construction of the new building (Block R) is progressing well and on track for the school to use from Day 1 Term 4.

- Refurbishment of Block D, which contains the homebases and satellite library, has continued with the new walkway and awning completed and the internal fit-out nearing completion.
- Work has continued on the Block N amenities with the new roof installed and internal fit-out starting.
- Construction of the new performance space has continued.

Next steps

- Block R will be completed, ready for the school to use from Day 1, Term 4.
- The school pavers will be installed in the landscaped areas of Block R.
- Refurbishment of Block D will be completed, ready for the school to use by mid-Term 4.
- Upgrades to Block N amenities will be completed.
- Construction of the new performance space will continue.
- Construction will start on the next phase of the project, which includes
 - demolition of Blocks C and F for improved connectivity and to make space for a new town centre/assembly area
 - o refurbishment of Blocks A, B and H.
