

Mona Vale Public School

Works notification

Friday 6 August 2021

A project is underway to deliver an upgrade to Mona Vale Public School. The project will provide new and upgraded learning spaces and core facilities including a performance space for shared use within the community. Main works began in June 2021 and are progressing well.

Demountable removal on site

As part of the project, existing temporary classrooms currently on site will progressively be removed from the school. These classrooms are in the south east corner of the site near Bungan Street, see map overleaf for further detail.

The work will take place between Friday 6 August 2021 and mid-September 2021. Once the demountables are removed the next stage of the building work will commence.

The work will take place during the following construction hours:

- 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday,
- 7:00am to 5:00pm Saturday, and
- 9:00am to 5:00pm Sunday.

Work completed on a Sunday is restricted to certain activities to minimise noise and impact to the community. No work will occur on public holidays.

A mobile crane will be installed for the demountables to be lifted safely around the school site. The crane will be on site throughout this stage of the project. During the lifting of demountables, traffic control measures will be in place. The removal of these buildings will not impact teaching and learning at Mona Vale Public School.

The mobile crane and construction vehicles will access the school site via the Emma Street carpark and Mona Vale Road. Traffic control will be in place during the movement of demountables for the safety of the school, motorists and the local community. Access will be maintained to all residential properties at all times. We apologise for any impact to local road users.

It is our highest priority to protect the health, safety and welfare of construction workers and our community during the COVID-19 pandemic.
