Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Mona Vale Public School. The project will deliver:

- A new Block R building containing 6 learning spaces and 3 support classes
- Upgrading and refurbishing Blocks B, D, E and H
- A new Block S Performing Arts Centre
- A new staff and administration space within Block R
- Removing Blocks C and G and improving space and connectivity throughout the school for all students.

Progress summary

The project has progressed well since the start of construction in June 2021.

Construction of the new Block R is continuing. The ground floor concrete slab and level 1 suspended concrete slab have been poured, the accessible pathway to the lift completed, and the sandstone blocks that form the Special Education Learning Unit (SELU) classroom covered outdoor learning area (COLA) installed.

Summer holiday works and next steps

Works will continue over the summer school holidays and will include; Block R upper-level concrete slab pours; landscaping to the area between Block R and the upper quadrant; and the start of refurbishment works to Block E, the Hall and Block N.

Refurbishments to student amenities, the Hall and Block E are expected to be completed in early Term 1, 2022, along with the new canteen. Works to complete the new Block E lift are to continue throughout Term. 1, 2022.

The reinstatement of the School's Time Capsule will coincide with the landscaping works to Building R in 2022.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction work hours over the summer school holidays will be as per the standard hours: Monday to Saturday, 7:00am to 6:00pm. No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements. Hoarding and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
