Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Mona Vale Public School. The project will deliver:

- A new Block R building containing 6 learning spaces and 3 support classes
- Upgrading and refurbishing Blocks B, D, E and H
- A new Block S Performing Arts Centre
- A new staff and administration space within Block R
- Removing Blocks C and G and improving open space and connectivity throughout the school for all students.

Progress summary

The schematic design has been endorsed by the Project Reference Group (PRG), a project governance group made up of the project team, teachers representing the school (including the Principal) and parents of students representing the parent community of Mona Vale Public School.

We are continuing to progress various authority approvals required prior to construction commencing on site, including with the Northern Beaches Council and relevant utility services.

SINSW recently held a Virtual Information Session and Information Booth for the Mona Vale Public School project. A total of 136 visitors attended the Virtual Information Session between Monday 17 May and Monday 24 May 2021. Thank you to everyone who attended and provided their feedback.

A construction contract has been awarded to Stephen Edwards Constructions to build the upgrade at Mona Vale Public School.

Next steps

Work started on site in mid-June 2021. A Works Notification has been issued to the community with further details of site establishment and work commencing.
