

Mona Vale Public School

Works notification

10 March 2021

Planning is underway to deliver an upgrade to Mona Vale Public School. The project will provide new and upgraded learning spaces and core facilities including a performance space for shared use within the community.

Demountable movements on site

As part of the project, additional temporary classrooms will be installed on the Northern boundary of the school site.

Once the additional temporary classrooms have been installed, the existing demountable classrooms on the South Eastern corner of the site will be removed.

Installation works will take place between Thursday 11 March 2021 and Saturday 17 April 2021, and the new temporary classrooms will be ready for the school to use from Day 1 Term 2 on Monday 19 April 2021.

Work will take place between Monday to Saturday, 7:00am to 5:00pm. There will be no access for construction vehicles between 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 3:30pm to minimise disruption during school drop-off and pick-up. We aim to have minimal impact on student's play space throughout the duration of the work.

A mobile crane will be installed to enable the facilities to be lifted safely around the school site. The crane will be on site from the end of March to early April. During crane operations, traffic control measures will be in place.

The mobile crane and construction vehicles will access the school site via the Waratah Street entrance. Traffic control will in place for the safety of the school, motorists and the local community. Access will be maintained to all residential properties at all times.

State Environmental Planning Policy 2017

These works are proceeding within guidelines of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Educational Establishments and Child Care Facilities) 2017 – Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.

38 Existing schools—exempt development

(1) Development for any of the following purposes is exempt development if it is on land within the boundaries of an existing school and complies with any requirements of this subclause that apply to the development—

(1) a short-term portable classroom (including its removal)—

(i) that is not more than 1 storey high, and

(ii) that is more than 5 metres from any property boundary with land in a residential zone and more than 1 metre from any property boundary with land in any other zone, and

(iii) that is removed within 24 months of being installed.
