Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Progress summary

The Monaro High School upgrade project aims to improve the functionality of the school, creating more flexible, innovative learning spaces to accommodate new ways of teaching.

In March the project team achieved another milestone with completion of Building A1 – the new Food and Textile Technology Unit, which includes:

- A commercial grade kitchen
- Food preparation and shared domestic kitchens
- A textiles workshop
- New learning facilities and rooms

The new facility has been in use by staff and students since the start of Term 2.

Next steps

Work will continue throughout the year to complete the project. Works include:

- Building B and Annex (metal work/ woodwork workshop and three future focused learning areas)
- Administration centre and Performing Arts Centre
- Upgrades to amenities (Building J).

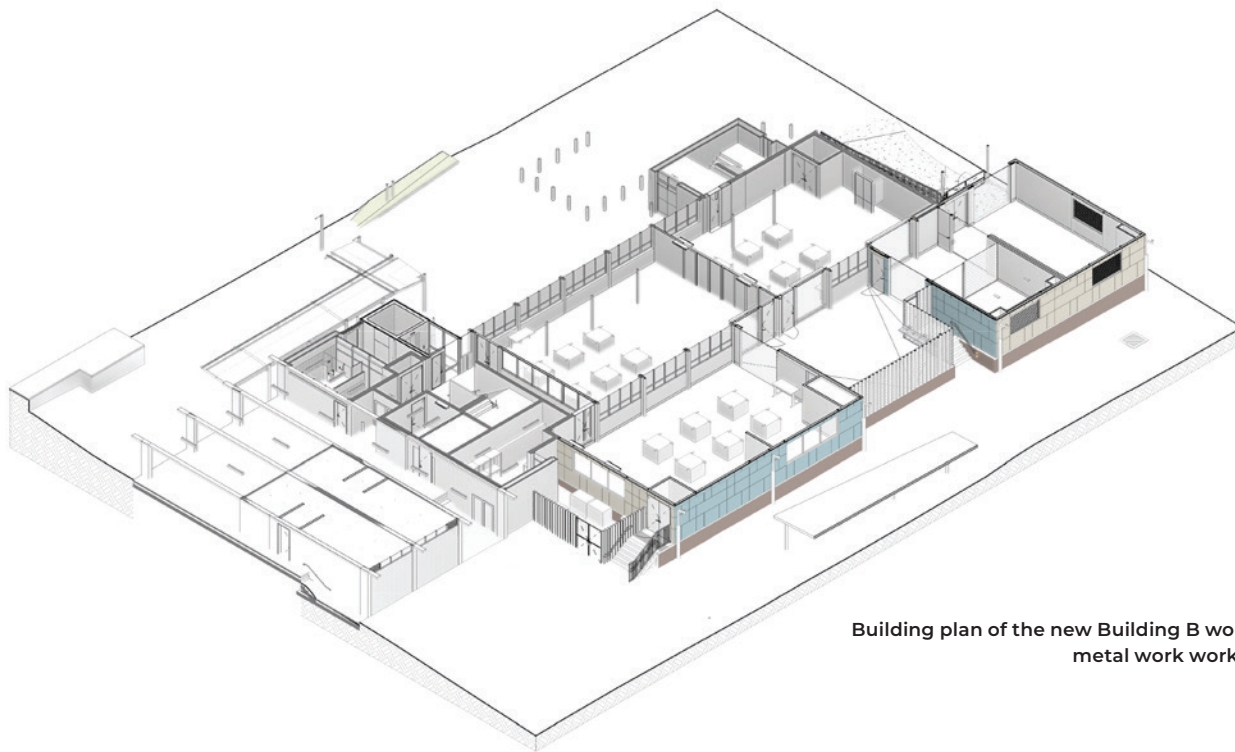
We will continue to work closely with the school and contractor to minimise disruption to teaching and learning.

Building B and return of indoor sports shed

Works to Building B are progressing well, with the metal work / woodwork workshops expected to be completed for the start of Term 3. With the completion of these works, equipment and machinery will be relocated from the current location (indoor sports shed), freeing up use for indoor PE classes and sporting activities.

Reminder of changes to traffic conditions on Yanni Street

The Snowy Monaro Regional Council's approved traffic changes on Yanni Street took effect from the start of Term 1, 2020. These changes are necessary to ensure the safety of the school and wider community during upgrades to Monaro High School. These changes include:

- Yanni Street has been converted from a two-way street to a one-way street, with traffic heading westbound towards Mittagang Road (Yarra Street will remain as a two-way).
- Angled on-street parking spaces along Yanni Street has been adjusted in line with the traffic directional change.
- Relocation of the school bus set-down area to Yanni Street.
