### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

### Project overview

We are upgrading the Support Unit at Moruya High School to better support students with additional needs. The project will replace the existing temporary classrooms with a Support Unit that will cater to the needs of students now and into the future.

The upgrade will deliver 7 new permanent support classroom spaces including practical activities areas, break out spaces, accessible toilet and change rooms, laundry, kitchen, and staffroom as well as an outdoor play area and a covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

All classrooms within the Support Unit will be fitted with air conditioning. Work will also include a new access road and undercover drop off area and car park.

### Progress update

The construction tender has closed and is being reviewed by the evaluation team. After the submission reviews are finished, a contractor will be selected to complete the works, and the contract will be awarded.

### Next steps

Once the contractor is appointed, we will be able to share the project's start date and anticipated completion timeline. Our goal is to start work as soon as possible, depending upon weather conditions and the necessary approvals.
