Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW.

This includes investment in the high potential and gifted education (HPGE) Partner School program, and Moruya High School will receive upgrades to facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE course offerings. We are also upgrading the Moruya Support Unit to better support students with disabilities and other special needs.

Support unit upgrade

We are upgrading the Support Unit at Moruya High School to better support students with additional needs. The project will replace the existing temporary classrooms with a Support Unit that will cater to the needs of students now and into the future. The upgrade will deliver:

- 7 permanent support classrooms with practical activities areas and break out spaces
- accessible toilets and changerooms with dedicated laundry, kitchen and staffroom
- covered outdoor learning area (COLA) with soft fall play surface and outdoor play area
- new access road with undercover drop off area
- all classrooms within the Support Unit will be fitted with air conditioning and the building will include solar power.

High potential gifted education upgrades

Under the HPGE Partner Schools program, Moruya High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE course offerings. The upgrades will include:

- Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) and Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) classrooms
- a sports court upgrade including new court surface, fencing and line marking
- a music room, performance area and sound studio
- facade upgrade to administration and library/science buildings
- Installing air conditioning across the school
- Improvements to senior lockers, a new covered walkway and automated front gate.

Progress summary

- Site establishment works started in September 2025 to prepare for construction of the support unit. These works include installation of temporary fencing around the site perimeter, setting up site office sheds, and establishing temporary power and water supply to the site.
- The construction timeline for the Support Unit has been finalised with the builder, and work is on track to have the support unit open for students Day 1 Term 2 2026.
- Early planning and design work is underway for the HPGE facility upgrades.

Next steps

- Start construction of the support unit. This will include leveling and working on the footings for the concrete slab.
- Continue planning and design work for the HPGE facility upgrades. Further updates about the planning and timeline for the HPGE facility upgrades will be shared with the school community once available.
- We will continue to work with our contractor to manage impacts on the local community, and in close consultation with Moruya High School leadership to ensure that school operations continue with minimal disruption.
