The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Moruya High School Support Unit

We are upgrading the Support Unit at Moruya High School to better support students with disabilities and additional needs. The Department of Education is committed to providing educational facilities that meets the needs and reduces the impact of disadvantage for children and young people with disabilities and additional needs, their families and the broader community.

The design is for seven new permanent classrooms spaces including practical activities areas, break out spaces, accessible toilet/change rooms, laundry, kitchen and staffroom as well as an outdoor play area and covered outdoor learning area (COLA) for students.

Works will also include a new access road and undercover drop off area and carpark for the precinct.

Progress summary

We are currently designing the new fit-for-purpose Support Unit at Moruya High School. The project will replace the existing demountables with a future focused Support Unit that will cater to the needs of students. We have undertaken a site review and a project user group has been formed to help inform planning and design.

We expect to share a concept design of the new building with the community in the coming months.
