Tower crane removal

On Saturday 20 May 2023, starting at 4 am the tower crane in the works zone at Mosman High School will be dismantled and removed from the work zone. The out of hours work is required as an oversized truck is required to remove the crane and vehicles of this size are not permitted to travel on NSW roads after 7 am.

This work will continue until 3.30 pm on Saturday and resume on Sunday from 7.30 am until 3.30 pm.

A temporary work zone will be set up on Belmont Avenue to house the vehicle and sections of the crane during its removal.

The work zone will be located on the westbound lane adjacent to Mosman High School. During these works, Belmont Avenue will remain open to vehicles traveling east toward Military Road.

Please see the map overleaf showing the location of the temporary work zone and the traffic changes to Belmont Road.

Mosman Council has approved this temporary closure of Belmont Road and a traffic management plan to ensure pedestrian and motorist safety during the removal of the crane. Road users are advised to follow the directions of traffic controllers and to expect some delays in accessing Military Road when parts of the crane are loaded into the temporary work zone.

This work is taking place on the weekend to minimise disruption to the school community. If the weather conditions this weekend do not allow for its safe removal or other delays are experienced, this work may take place on Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 May 2023.
