Project overview

The Mosman High School upgrade will deliver students the latest educational facilities for teaching and learning. The project includes:



An increase of **16** new flexible learning spaces



A new library



A new multipurpose gym / hall



New outdoor and rooftop play spaces



New canteen facilities



New administration and staff facilities

Progress summary

- The projects State Significant Development application was approved on 6 August 2021
- The early works in Building D are progressing well
- Four temporary classrooms and library with student amenities have been installed

Next steps

- Finish early works in Building D to provide temporary staff and administration facilities during construction
- Site establishment for main works construction
- Start main works construction in late 2021
- Award the main works contract

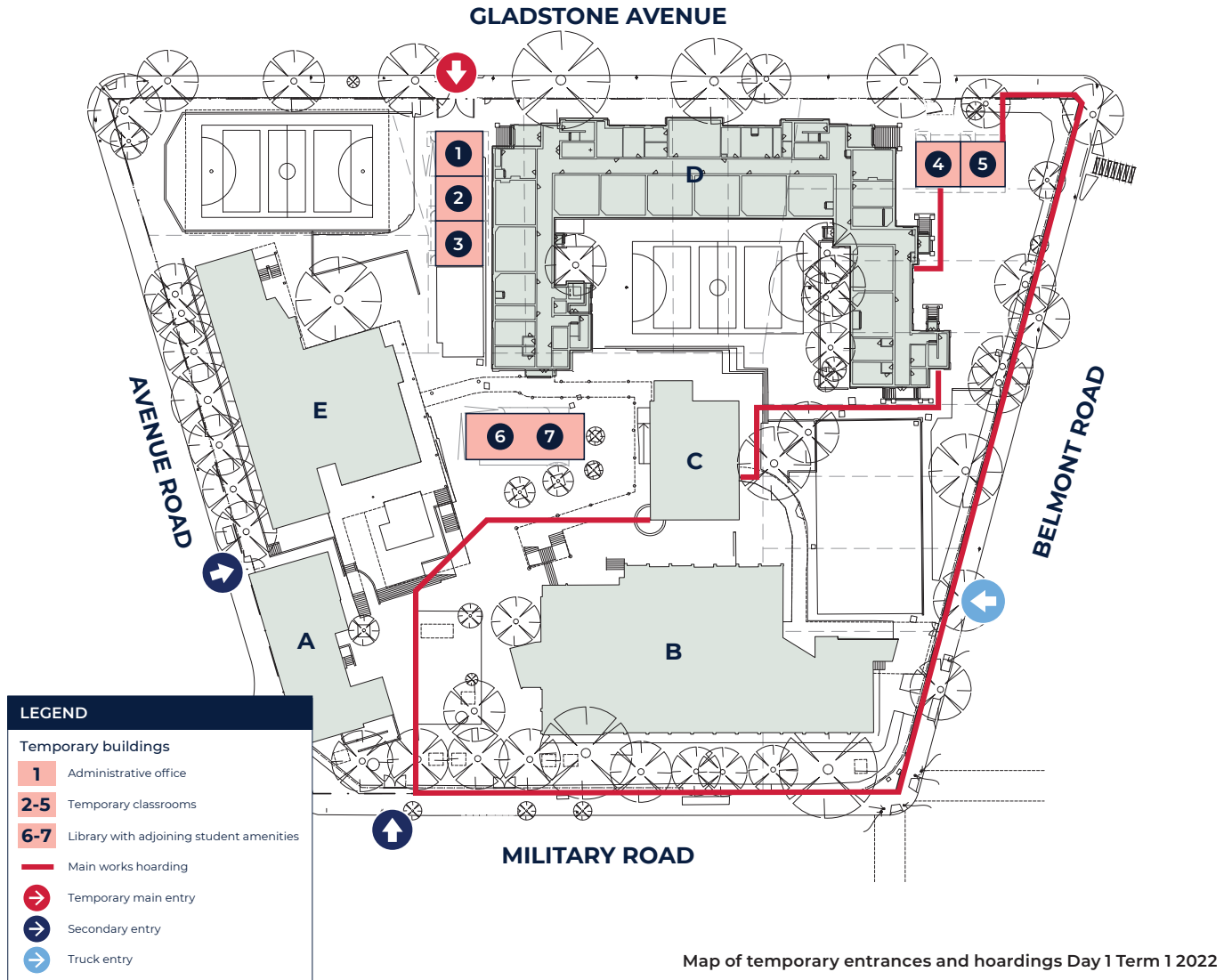


School upgrade map

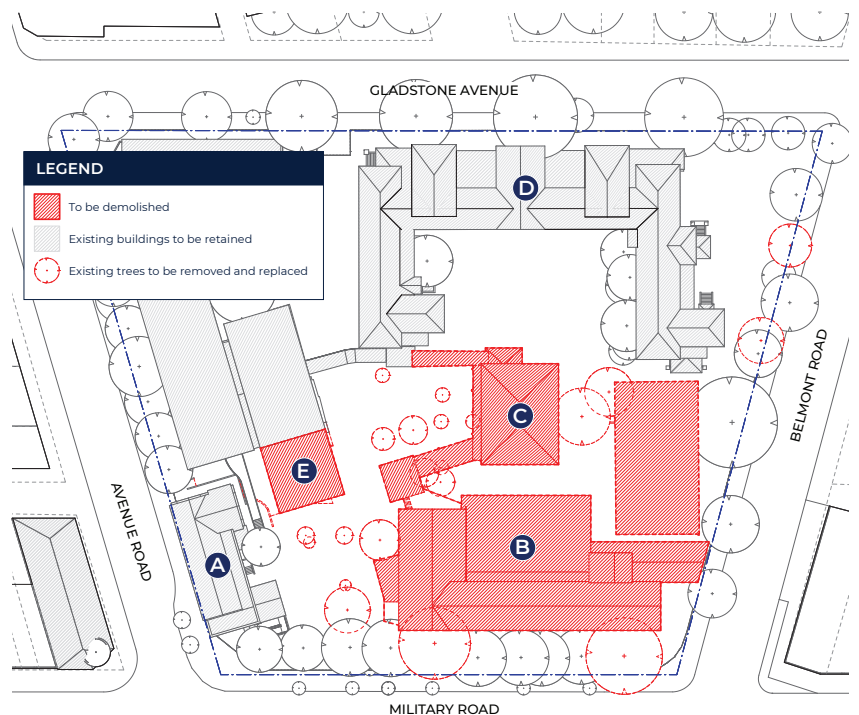
Scope of demolition works

Demolition works will take place over two phases to reduce disruption to the school community.

Phase one will demolish Building B and part of Building E.

Phase two will demolish Building C.

The map below shows the buildings to be demolished and the existing trees to be removed and replaced. The existing buildings to be retained are also shown.



Frequently asked questions

What does this information pack include?

An overview of the Mosman High School upgrade and information for the school community about the arrangements in place to support school operations and reduce disruption during the main construction works.

When will construction works start?

The main construction works will start in late 2021 after the Higher School Certificate examinations have finished.

How will the students be safely separated from the construction works?

Hoardings will be placed around the work zone to safely separate students from the construction works.

What alternative learning spaces will be in place during the works?

To ensure students have equivalent learning spaces during construction, four temporary classrooms and a library with student amenities have been installed.

Mosman Club Auditorium on Military Road and Scots Kirk Church Hall on Belmont Road have both been secured to provide additional spaces for students during construction.

How will students safely access these off-site locations?

A Safety Management Plan will be in place to manage the safe passage of students using off-site facilities.

Where will the main entrance to the school be during construction?

For the duration of construction, the school's main entrance will be on Gladstone Avenue. See the hoardings and temporary entrances map for the location of the school's entrances and exits during construction.

Where will the school entrances be once the upgrade is finished?

There will be a new main entry on Belmont Avenue, near the new administration facilities. The existing secondary entrances on Gladstone Avenue, Belmont Road and Military Road will also be retained.

Will the upgrade increase the school's student capacity?

There will be a small capacity increase from about 1,100 to 1,200 students.

What is a State Significant Development (SSD) application?

State Significant Development (SSD) applications are used for projects that have a special significance to the people and State of NSW. The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) is responsible for the planning approval process of SSD applications.
