Early services works during winter school holidays

During the winter school holidays, Saturday 26 June to Monday 12 July 2021, the project team will be undertaking some preliminary early and enabling works as part of the Mosman High School upgrade.

Works include:

- Site investigations
- Trenching and excavating
- Utility and services upgrades
- Saw cutting and jack hammering
- Concrete pouring
- Tree removal

These works are being undertaken during the school holidays to minimise disruption to staff and students. The team will be providing further updates in relation to other early and enabling works as the project progresses.

The project team will make every effort to minimise construction noise and don't anticipate these works impacting nearby residents.

Working hours

Work hours will be from 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Saturday.

Why are trees being removed?

The project team are removing two trees on school grounds to allow for the installation of temporary buildings that will service the school when main works start. As part of the vegetation and landscaping plan, the project will be replacing any trees removed as part of the Mosman High School upgrade.
