Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Works will continue at both sites over the summer holidays and include continued demolition at the Griffith site, removal of concrete sections at the Wade site and concrete slabs pours at both sites.

What are the construction working hours?

This work will take place between 7:30am and 6:00pm Monday to Friday, and from 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturday, weather and site conditions permitting. The community will be kept informed of any changes to the approved working hours.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No. There will be a shutdown period from 20 December 2019 to 5 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

Health and safety is our highest priority. We will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure that construction works will be scheduled and managed to minimise impacts to the community where possible.

Both sites will be secured and areas where construction is taking place will be fenced off. There will be continued security patrols in place (Wade site) and security will be increased over the Christmas period.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

There may be some noise impacts as a result of demolition at the Griffith site, concrete cutting at the Wade site and concrete pouring at both sites. All possible care will be taken to limit these impacts.

Hoarding and shade cloth has been installed at both sites to reduce dust and noise impacts on our neighbours. Dust from demolition and construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Trucks entering and leaving the site are required to cover their loads.

How will traffic be managed?

There will be large vehicles accessing both sites during the summer holidays to continue works. Project personnel will be in place to help vehicles enter and exit the sites safely. Construction traffic will be managed according to the traffic management plan.
