As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the department is carrying out essential maintenance and other works to improve facilities at Murwillumbah East Public School.

Asbestos removal

During the upcoming school holidays, our contractors will be carrying out some work in some rooms on the first floor of the main school building – Block B.

This will involve removing a small amount of asbestos containing material from flooring. The material has been confirmed as bonded asbestos which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Work to remove the asbestos containing materials will be carried out on **Wednesday 9 October 2024**, during the school holiday period. Vacation care will move offsite during the asbestos removal.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws, and the site-specific Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Once work is complete, the area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be provided before the classrooms are returned to use by the school.

Work to re-paint and install new floor coverings, pinboard linings, fans and air conditioning in the rooms will continue into Term 4. Kindergarten classes that currently use the spaces, will be learning in Block A from the beginning of next term.
