

Murwillumbah East Public School

Works notification | 7 April 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the department is carrying out maintenance and other works to improve facilities at Murwillumbah East Public School.

Remediation works

During the upcoming school holidays, our contractors will be removing a small amount of asbestos containing material from ground floor ceiling linings and balconies on the top floor of the main school building at Murwillumbah East Public School.

The material has been confirmed as bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Work to remove the asbestos containing take place on 14 April 2025 and there will be no students or school staff on site during this time.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws, and the NSW Department of Education Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the area is returned to use by the school.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority.
