

# Murwillumbah High School upgrade

Project update | December 2023

School Infrastructure NSW is upgrading Murwillumbah High School so that students and teachers can return to the school from the beginning of the 2025 school year.

## Project overview

The project will provide upgraded classrooms, library, bathrooms and change rooms, and staff spaces, with new painting, floor covering, furniture, and air conditioning. The detailed scope of works for the upgrade is continuing to be developed in consultation with local educational leaders.

## Progress update

Work has started to prepare the Murwillumbah High School site for the upgrading works, which are expected to begin in early 2024.

- A site office has been set up at the school as a base for cleaning and site activities.
- Contractors are removing any remaining loose furniture, equipment and rubbish and cleaning indoor and outdoor spaces.
- Quotes are being received from contractors for planned works.

## Next steps

- Inspection of all buildings to check their condition, determine work required and validate historical information held about school buildings.
- Installation of hoarding around the site and additional security upgrades.
- Planned maintenance of the agricultural areas.
- Preparing documents needed to meet statutory planning requirements for the upgrade works.

## Summer holiday works

Work that will be happening at the school over the summer break is not expected to be disruptive to neighbouring residents. Works notifications will be issued prior to any major demolition or construction work at the site.
